### **SUBTHEMES:**

**1. Safety and compassion in Health and Social Care Practice**

Patient/client safety is key to the commissioning of education programs as well as health and social care services. This subtheme will offer an opportunity to reflect on this as well as the role of compassion in being a health or social care practitioner. It will consider how we can engender these values and attitudes within the education process.

**2. Patient/client inclusion as experts by experience**

Service users, their families and carers have been important contributors to health and social care service planning and evaluation for some time. This subtheme will give an opportunity to explore their role in the design of education programs as "Experts by Experience".

**3. Technology to support human wellbeing**

Learning technology and welfare technology are making rapid advances to improve both education and practice in health and social care. Consequently, the emerging technologies provide opportunities to enhance patient/client participation, safety and wellbeing in a variety of ways. Keynote speakers and workshop leaders will share the latest advances in this field with participants.

**4. Simulation pedagogy**

This subtheme will offer participants the opportunity to explore the role and methods of using simulation in learning and teaching. The variations of simulation pedagogy in ensuring the quality of education and safety of care will be highlighted.
