How to get to Vic

Closest airports: El Prat (±70km from Vic) and Girona Airport (±60km away). From Girona Airport there is a bus to Girona city centre. From there you can take the Eix Bus to Vic. Some buses on this route stop at the airport too. A train service runs every 30 minutes from Barcelona Airport to Barcelona-Sants, where you can take a connection to Vic (Line 3).
