Short description

Throughout the three days you will work hands on in interdisciplinary teams on innovation challenges and you will learn or enhance your knowledge with methods of the human-centred design process (Design Thinking). You will engage with real people to understand their needs and use prototyping tools to test the ideas developed during the course. The aim is to get a sprint experience of a learning environment as it is envisioned for the future student learning lab. On Thursday evening there will be a social dinner.

During the 4 days you will:

- ... recognize and solve user`s service needs in cooperation with stakeholders
- ... learn to develop, prototype and test a service concept of a real-world problem
- ... work as part of an interdisciplinary and international team
- ... learn about our vision of a student learning lab and the pedagogy behind it
- ... reflect your learnings and the value that it could create in your own work environment / your future
